Getting started is easy. Download the app, grab an AppleTV, Chromebit or an iPod and plug it into your digital signage screen. Then Upload, Approve and Playback!

HOW IT WORKS



Upload

Simply upload your videos via the TrilbyTV app, give your video a title, description and tag to a screen.



Playback

The TrilbyTV Player app works on devices from Apple, Microsoft and Google. Use the unique code to connect your screens.



Manage

See all of your screens with one interface and manage content easily by configuring scheduling and playlists.

PLAYER OPTIONS

AppleTV (2015 model onwards)



The AppleTV with Siri remote makes a great player for TrilbyTV. It connects to your screen via a HDMI cable and requires a single 13 amp socket. The AppleTV can be securely mounted to the back of your screen.

TrilbyTV Player for AppleTV is a free download on the TV App Store, just login, select your categories or playlist and press play. TrilbyTV Player on AppleTV fully supports the Siri remote which can be used to skip through clips during playback (swipe left or right) and also to control playback via the play/pause button.

Asus Chromebit CS10



The ASUS Chromebit CS10 is a computer on a stick which connects directly to the HDMI port on the side of your screen. It is powered via a small adaptor which requires a regular 13 amp socket. To operate the Chromebit you will need a USB or Bluetooth keyboard and mouse (Logitech K400 works well)

TrilbyTV Player for Chrome is available from the Chrome Web Store and once installed just login, select your categories or playlist and press play. TrilbyTV Player for Chrome has an autostart feature so if the stick looses power for any reason, when it restarts TrilbyTV will begin to play full screen straight away.



PLAYER OPTIONS CONTINUED

Amazon fireTV stick



The Amazon fireTV stick is a low cost consumer device to allow any TV screen to play back streaming content. It is based on the Android OS and has been specifically designed to display video from platforms like TrilbyTV.

TrilbyTV Player is available to download from the Amazon store and once installed will display a TrilbyTV Player Code or gives you the option to login. The TrilbyTV Player app will register itself to auto start if the stick loses power for any reason.

Apple iPod Touch



Apple's iPod touch is well suited for TrilbyTV playback being a small light device which can easily be hidden behind a TV screen. You will need to purchase an Apple 5W USB Power Adapter (MD812) and an Apple Lightning Digital AV Adapter (MD826) which will connect the iPod Touch to a TV screen via HDMI.

TrilbyTV Player for iOS is available from the iTunes App Store. Once installed just login, select your categories or playlist and press play. You can skip clips with a swipe on the screen during playback.

Windows or Mac computer



Any desktop or laptop Windows or Mac OS X computer can playback TrilbyTV content. So long as the device is capable of playing back a full screen video, TrilbyTV will work. You can even use a small form factor windows PC which can be attached to the back of a screen.

For either Windows or Mac OS X you will need to download the Chrome web browser. Once downloaded go to the Chrome Web Store and download TrilbyTV Player for Chrome. Then just login, select your categories or playlist and press play. TrilbyTV Player for Chrome has an autostart feature so if the computer looses power for any reason when it restarts TrilbyTV will begin to play full screen straight away. You will need to ensure Chrome is set to Launch on Startup for this to work.
